In the crush the unsettled steers just tended to keep trying to push through the front of the crush and would not settle or stand still. One steer did not like pressure when I was in a smaller yard with him - he was not aggressive but just watchful and wary.

Assessor Comments	A small line of EU accredited Angus cross steers with good growth for age and medium to large frame. The full drop of the steers are in this sale as well as a line of heifers. Note the main line of steers is a line of Angus x Angus with these being the Angus cross steers. Approx half the steers are out of own bred Angus cows by Booroomooka bulls M475(AI) or Booroomooka M410(AI), the other half are out of purchased Angus and Angus cross cows from Emmaville which are principally Clunie Range or Mundoo Angus blood. Note they are grass market eligible in that they have not been fed grain. They have not been fed cotton seed nor have they been treated with antibiotics. Two steers noted with healing hairloss spots on face and neck and one with a slight blue eye spot - nothing detrimental. Note vendor also has the sisters of these steers listed in this sale to help fill loads.
