Steers very clean in the muzzle with no nasal discharge that is sometimes prevalent in weaners at this time of year and this indicates they are in good health. There were 3 that were ringed & 1 that was cut out of the entire line of 204 head on Wednesday 1st June. Also noted 1 steer with a few warts around one eye and another with a birth a mark. These bred on lighter country, history would suggest they will really hit their straps if they are exposed to crop or winter herbage. These have had no detrimental growth setback at any stage. They exhibit very good muscling, bone, softness, depth of barrel and great length. To be delivered as a "run of the gate" into even lines.
