Ideal Steers to grow out for the Supermarket Trade or Heavy Export Markets. They have Good Feet, Tidy Heads & are Quiet. There are approximately 10 Steers with very slight Humps that might not suit the supermarket trade, however the rest are genuine flatbacks. Majority are No.2's with the odd late No.1 Steer. Majority of these Steers are 6 - 12 months old with 48 previously weaned Steers & 54 freshly weaned Steers that will be tailed out prior to delivery. There were 4 of heaviest & oldest looking Steers mouthed with solid Milk Teeth. There are 5 fresh Weaners coddled up (fat in purse), 2 Steers with Blue Eye Scarring in 1 eye, 3 Steers with a coin sized wart, 4 Steers that look a bit masculine from being late cut, 1 Steer with fresh Pinkeye (treated at assessment) & 1 Steer with a cricket ball sized lump in his navel.
