Steers would be ideally suited to oats to take through to feeder weights or alternatively have the capacity to make great grass bullocks. Please note 5 were only castrated 10 days ago , 1 has a slightly cloudy eye and a couple have fly rub marks none of which are are considered detrimental.
