Very fertile heifers with only 1 not conceiving from the joining. These heifers were quiet in the yards and will make a good addition to an existing herd or to trade or start a herd. Please note 2 heifers have recent pink eye scarring in one eye (refer photos) not detrimental to their performance as breeders. Quality young heifers with their whole future ahead of them.
