Assessor Comments	A NICE LINE OF GENUINE YOUNG BRAHMAN BREEDER FEMALES WHICH ARE SURPLUS TO THE VENDORS REQUIREMENTS DUE TO BEING FULLY STOCKED.THESE FEMALES PRESENT IN PREDOMINANTLY FORWARD STORE TO PRIME CONDITION DUE TO A PROLONGED WET SEASON. THESE HEIFERS ARE JOINED TO YOUNG RED BRAHMAN BULLS (AS PICTURED) WHICH ARE STATION BRED THAT HAVE BEEN SELECTED OUT OF A HIGHLY FERTILE GROUP OF POLL COWS. AS MENTIONED THE VENDOR HAS UTILISED SELECT BULL SALES WITHIN THE DISTRICT. THE VENDOR HAS SPENT TIME ROTATIONAL GRAZING THESE HEIFERS AND THEY HAVE HAD EXTENSIVE EXPOSURE TO BIKES, DOGS AND HORSES. PLEASE MAKE NOTE THAT 4 HEIFERS IN THIS ASSESSMENT HAD FLY LESIONS EVIDENT AND WERE COMPLETELY HEALED AT THE TIME OF THE ASSESSMENT, THIS IS DEEMED NOT DETRIMENTAL TO THEIR HEALTH.
