These heifers present in store condition as a result of very wet conditions in heavy black soil for an extended period of time which has affected animal performance. On good feed and dry conditions it is expected they would bound ahead. Please note one heifer is cloudy eyed in both eyes but does not seem to affect vision and one heifer has a blue spot on one of her eyes.
