These 5 decks of heifers would be suitable to either join to bulls of your choice or feed for the domestic supermarket trade. I had a scale malfunction and was not able to weigh any of the heifers. The previous afternoon I had weighed their brothers so I am confident in estimating their weight. I estimate heifers range from 120-250 kg and average 175kg. Buyers please note it is the weight at Cloncurry registered scales that payment of c/kg live will be calculated on. There is 59 heifers that have just been fresh branded but they have not been de-horned or earmarked. The 171 remaining heifers have all been well dehorned. They have good feet. They have been weaned over the past 2 weeks and some on the day of assessment. Most weaners that have been in hand for a few days have quietened down very well. They have not been educated outside of the yard.
